Year 7 and 8 Projects and Homework Next Week

- **Literacy and Numeracy:** This week KS3 have been designing their own video game.

Homework this week is to design a character to appear in your game.

- **Science and Technology:** Following on from your Space Hunt last week, this week your task is to design your own planet. Have a think about what your planet would look like, what resources it would have and who would live on it.

- **Humanities and Media:** This week we are going to look at religions around the world in lessons. Your homework is to choose a religious building from around the world and build it out of anything you have at home.

- **Art and Health Independent Learning:** Following on from last week students will plan and follow a healthy diet for a week, including amount of exercise, sleep and water. Then review/compare the two weeks diets.

Year 9 GCSE Foundation Projects and Homework Next Week

- **English** Students begin to practice how to analyse language in an unseen text. They should complete Question 2 from the Homework booklet to show they can do this **independently**.

- **Mathematics** This week we intend to dwell on part 2 and 3 of the football fan project we have more challenging tasks. In the event of a student finishing part 2 and 3 of the project, as a back up i have assigned individualised task of similar nature using my Maths.

- **Science-** This week your task is to find definitions for the key words :extinction, variation, species, variation and biodiversity. You can use BBC Bitesize to help or ask me for a revision guide.

-**History** This week you will be finding out how Americans broke the Prohibition rules and start to look at Al Capone and how he broke the rules. You will need to complete task 4,5 and 6.

- **Food Technology** - This week we will be finding out why beans, nuts and seeds are important. Learn the nutritional benefits of each in our diet.

- **Art** - Senses project 'Hearing' so Year 10 will be painting in response to music, using oil pastel.

- **PE** - This week you be working your way through the PE booklet focusing on the muscular system and respiratory system pages 13-18.

Year 10 - GCSE Tasks and Homework Next Week

- **English**- Students practice how to analyse language in an unseen text and begin to explore how a story is organised to create effect on the reader.
- **Maths**- Going in depth with Percentages and associated to real life situation such as mortgages, sales also looking at simple and compound interest.
